Mardi Gras By The Sea Parade & Festival



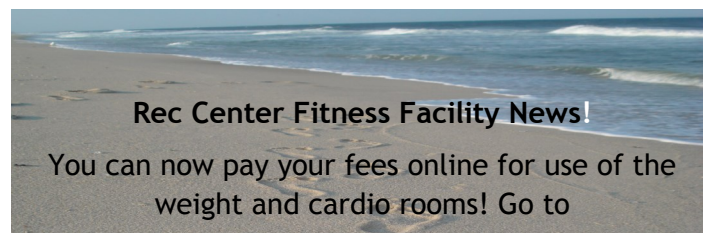
