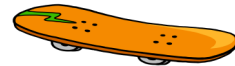
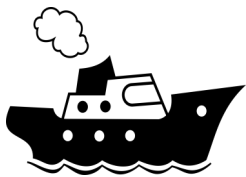


History Series: African Americans in the USN in the Civil War
