The last concert of the summer will be held Thursday, August 30th,



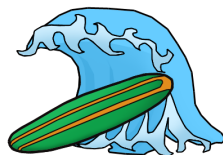

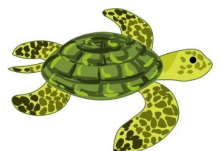

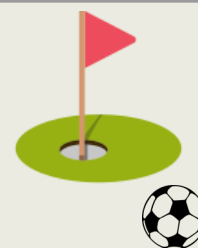
