 3/4 cup small birdseed 1 packet of unflavored gelatin 1/4 cup water Cookie Cutters Parchment Paper Straw 	 Twine Bird Seed Cookie Camera Decoration Supplies (color pencils, markers, painting, etc.) Paper
Directions	Directions
 Boil water over medium heat. Add in packet of unflavored gelatin.Stir until gelatin is dissolved (I-2 mins). Take gelatin off heat and let set for a couple of minutes. Mix with bird seed. Place cookie cutters on a piece of parchment paper.Scoop the bird seed into cookie cutters, and using another piece of parchment paper, press the birdseed down. Stick a straw in the top of each filled cookie cutter to create a small hole. Set cookie cutters in the freezer for 20 minutes.Remove cookie cutters from the freezer, and let them sit in room temperature for approximately 10 minutes. Carefully push the bird seed feeders out of the cookie cutters. 	 Thread a piece of twine through the hole at the top of the bird seed feeder and tie it into a loop. Place a Bird Seed Cookie in an easy to view location in your yard Take photos of the birds who visit your yard Pick out your favorite photo and draw a picture to send to family and friends
