While paint dries, color & decorate Bunny Stencils. 4. Cut out each Bunny Stencil. 2. Add Potting Soil 5. Once dried, glue/tape bunny feet to the front of your can where **3. Follow Seed Packet or Potted Flower as plant directions** the can meets the table.


6. Tape/Glue Bunny Ears to the back side of the can (facing forward in the same direction as the feet). Ears should be attached at the top.

7. Glue Googly Eyes / Draw Eyes with Sharpie on the front of tin can at the top.

8. Glue/Tape Bunny Nose under the eyes of your tin bunny.
