## Morning Craft Project

# Peter Cot"tin" Planters

## Supplies

- Large recycled tin can (28oz)
- Bunny Stencils (Provided Below)
- Coloring Supplies
- White Paint
- 2 Large Googly Eyes (Or Color On Your Eyes)
- Glue/ Tape
- Scissors,
- Black Sharpie

## Directions

1. Clean and dry your large recycled Tin Can.
2. Once dry, paint your tin can using the white paint.
3. While paint dries, color & decorate Bunny Stencils.
4. Cut out each Bunny Stencil.
5. Once dried, glue/tape bunny feet to the front of your can where the can meets the table.
6. Tape/Glue Bunny Ears to the back side of the can (facing forward in the same direction as the feet). Ears should be attached at the top.
7. Glue Googly Eyes / Draw Eyes with Sharpie on the front of tin can at the top.
8. Glue/Tape Bunny Nose under the eyes of your tin bunny.

## Supplies

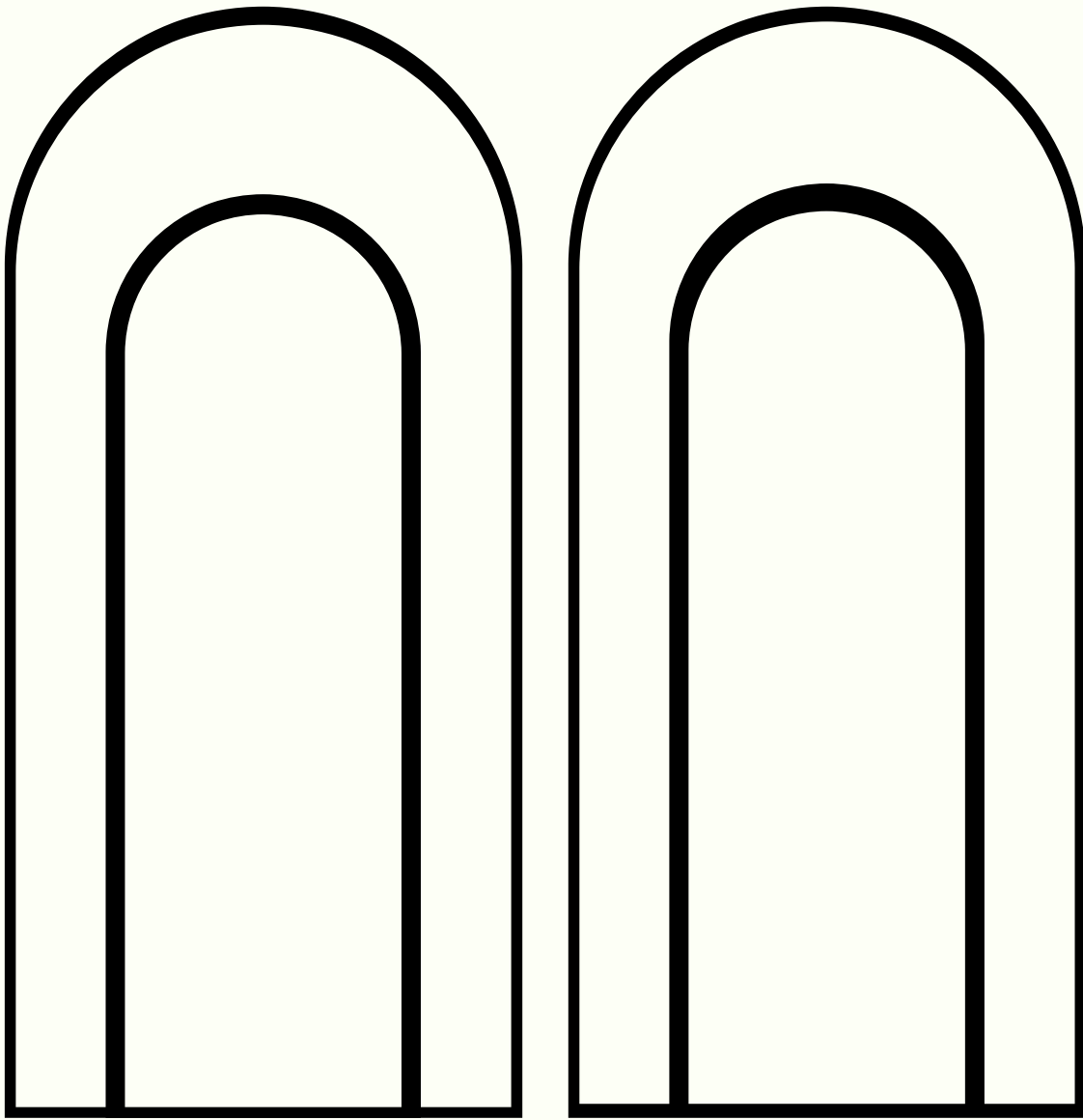
- Completed Peter Cot"tin" Planter

- Potting Soil
- Flower Seeds/ Small Potted Flower (Daffodils, Tulips, etc)

## Directions

1. Spread Draining Material across the bottom of Peter Cot"tin" Planter
2. Add Potting Soil
3. Follow Seed Packet or Potted Flower as plant directions provide
4. Place your Easter Garden in a sunny spot just in time for the holiday weekend.

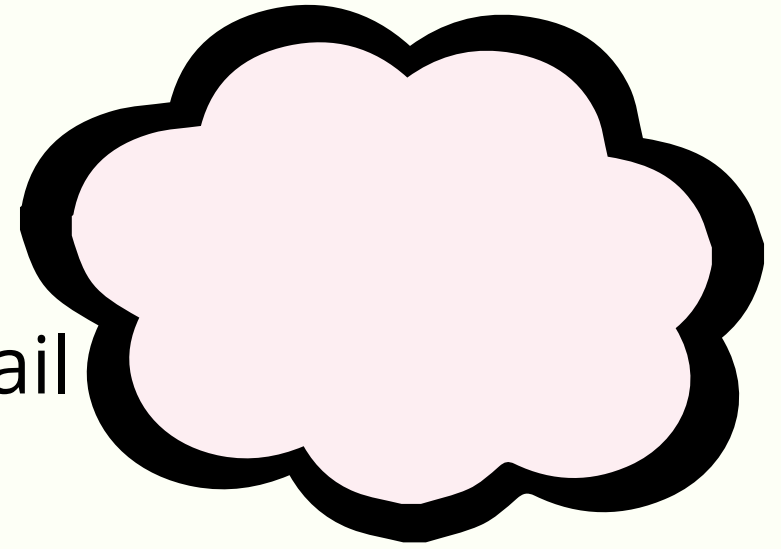

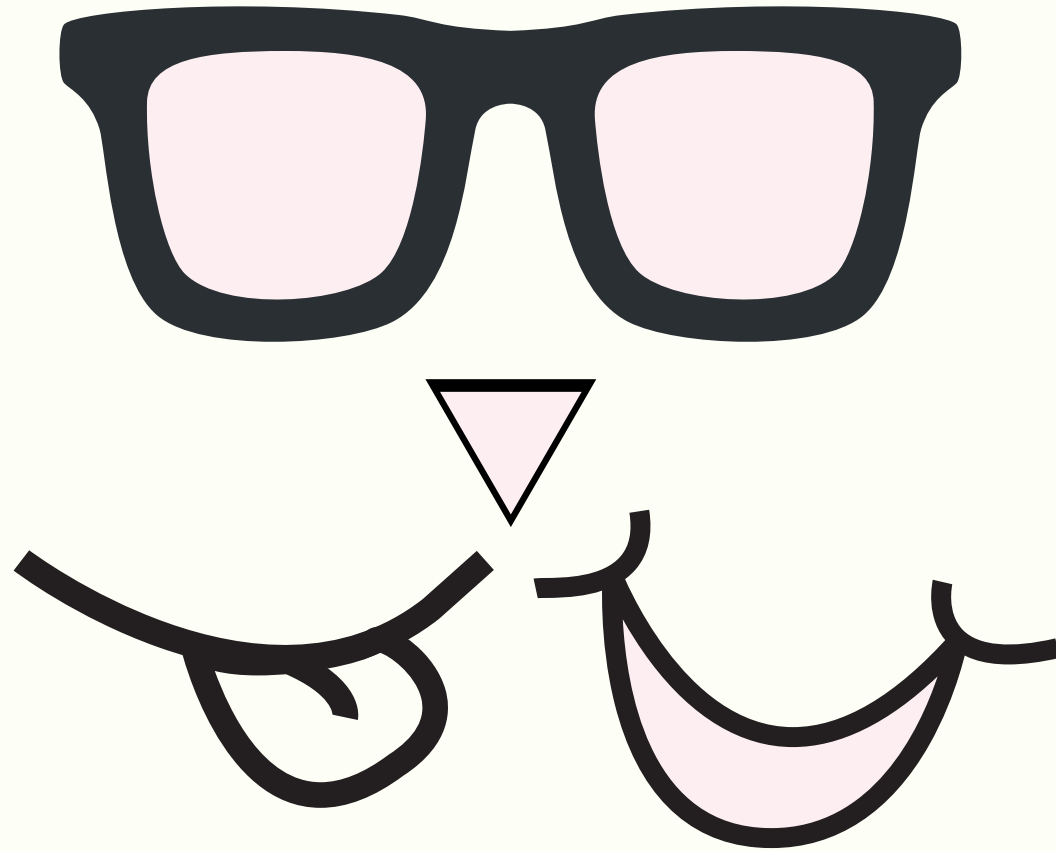
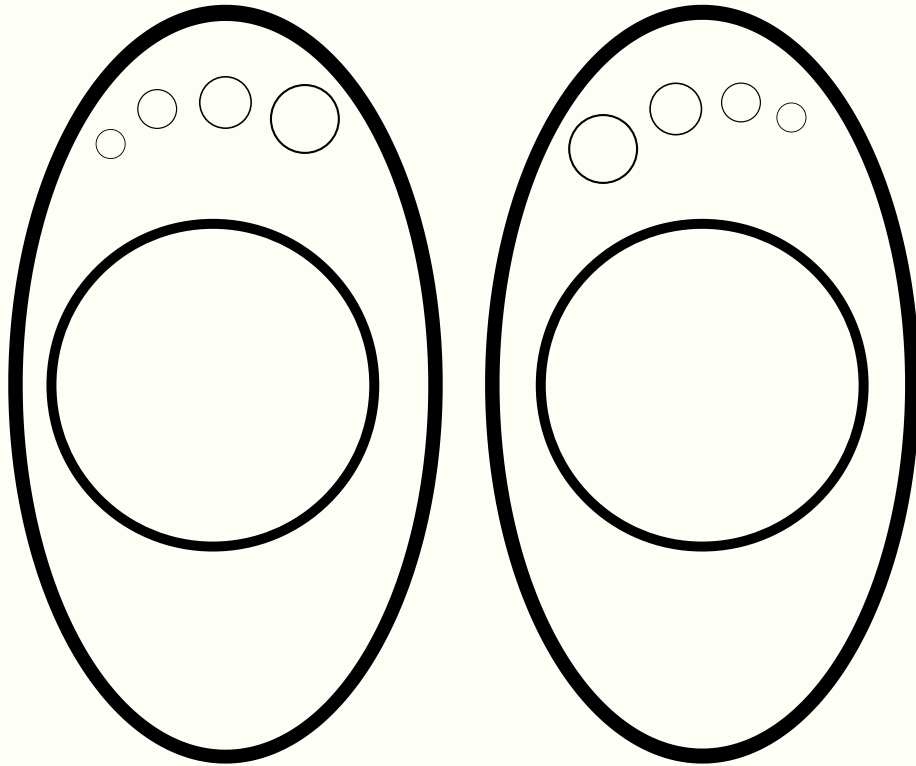
