Morning Craft Project

Tie Die Color Exploration

Supplies

- Coffee Filters
- Crayola Markers:
Classic Colors or Extreme Colors
- newspaper
- disposable gloves

Directions

1. Use Crayola Markers. Bright colors are best.
*Patterns look great
 2. You only need to color half of the filter to get awesome results.
 3. After coloring, fold the filter in half and half again until it's a wedge shape.
 4. Allow to dry completely
- *Use only small amounts of water at a time to avoid over diluting

Practice Writing

- Pipecleaners
- Clothespins
- Clothes Hanger
- glue
- Fishing Line/ String
- Scissors
- Tie Die Coffee Filter

Directions

1. Pinch together one filter.
2. Clip the middle of filter with clothespin.
3. Serving as the antenna, glue desired length of pipe cleaner to one end of the clothespin .
4. Cut various lengths of fishing line and attached to each "butterfly". *Can be tied or glued
5. Tie the remaining end of fishing line to clothes hanger.
6. Hang you completed project in a window or sunny place to welcome the spring season!
